

Orangeville OSPCA 2019 Mom 2 Mom Sale Terms and Conditions

Thank you for joining us in support of the Orangeville & District SPCA. The following are a list of guidelines and tips to ensure a successful sale!

- You will be assigned a designated selling space complete with a 6 ft table and a chair. All proceeds that you make from the sale of your items are yours to keep. Proceeds from the entrance fees and table rentals collected will be donated to the Orangeville & District SPCA
- Tables are provided on a first come, first serve basis and will need to be paid for prior to the event either over the phone by calling the Orangeville & District Animal Centre or by visiting the centre in person. 650 Riddell Road, Orangeville or 519-942-3140.
- Parent tables are \$25 each and a limited amount of vendor tables will be available for \$30 each
- Table setup will be from 7:30-9:30 a.m. Latecomers will not be permitted to set up mid-sale, even if they have prepaid for their table.
- Sellers must be available for the entire sale from 9:30-1:30 p.m. Packing up may begin 15 minutes prior the end of the sale
- All sale items must fit in the seller's designated space and may not block aisles
- Your Items can be new or gently used and must be in good working condition
- Absolutely no recalled items may be sold
- Selling of car seats is not permitted
- Sellers must provide their own change and bags
- Sellers must clean up all of their garbage and either dispose of it in a designated area or take it home with them
- Leftover items that sellers would like to donate need to be left in the clear garbage bags by the entrance at the end of the sale. Leftover items will be donated to the Paws & Claws thrift stores in Orangeville and Shelburne and to the Canadian Kidney Foundation and to Diabetes Canada
- If you bring children with you to the sale, you are responsible for supervising the children at all times
- You are responsible for pricing, tagging and arranging your own items in your selling space
- You are responsible for your items and money, sellers will not be reimbursed for any lost or stolen items or money

Please note that all table rental monies, once submitted, cannot be refunded past February 1st.

ATTENTION VENDORS we will only allow one vendor per company to be represented at the sale. This will be determined on a first come, first served basis. Space will be given to the first vendor of each company who completes agrees to the above terms and provides full payment.

Tips for Selling Your Items at a Mom-to-Mom Sale

- Come prepared! Bring enough bags
- Come with plenty change
- Don't leave your money accessible to the general public
- Ensure that you get to the sale allowing plenty of time to set up your area(s) in an organized manner
- You might be offered a lower price at one time or another. It is up to you if you want to bargain. You do not have to take anything less than you want. Remember you are reselling used items and will not get retail price for them
- Make sure if you have items under the table that they are accessible and easy to see
- Making a sign to let the public know what size and sex of clothes you have will make things go easier
- Clearly label each item with price AND size. It also helps to sort your items by size by using containers, boxes, size dividers, etc
- Make sure that your items are CLEAN. If there is a problem (zipper needs replacing, etc.), you should make sure that is known. It is the responsibility of the buyer to check it out, but if you are up front and let them know, they will know that your table is a reputable one
- If you are selling two & three-piece outfits, it might be a good idea to connect them together by safety pins, hang on a 2-3 piece hanger, or stitch together with a single run thru with needle and thread
- It is a good idea to have a helper with you. You want to make sure that someone is at your table at all times in the event that you need to step away from your table
- If you are not willing to barter on the price, post a sign that says, "All prices are firm". On the other hand, if you are willing to barter, you may want to put a sign saying "No reasonable offers refused."
- If you are sharing a table with someone else, make sure that you have different tags to collect as you make the sale to assure both parties get their rightful monies
- Remember that this will be a long day so ensure that you bring snacks and water with you.
- Make sure all your items are clean. Do your best to get out stains. If you are selling large items, make sure you clean those also; people are more likely to buy an item that looks newer, than one where they would have to
